The meeting was called to order by the President, Shandra Kisailus followed by a moment of silence. Roll was taken.

Shandra and Justin discussed the snow plowing cost variances. Shandra provided a cost breakdown for the past two years of snow plowing. A discussion regarding the termination ensued. Brian Correll said they would be able to file an unemployment claim. Al Bonk said he would volunteer to load salt when needed. Jolene said it violated the Sunshine Law. It was unclear if any section of The Sunshine Law was violated, Shandra will seek Atty. Menns advice. Marie Correll advised Council to make sure names of employees who operate Borough owned equipment is updated with the insurance company.

Brian Correll said the back to the truck that was taken off to install the spreader fell over. It should be picked up and properly stored.

A discussion regarding the storage of the truck under the pavilion was entertained. Gloria noted that proper storage facilities are needed to house Borough equipment.
